OF
COMMUNITY SERVICE BOARD VOLUNTEER

A volunteer or trainee (whether an individual or serving as a member of a civic group) is one who provides a singular or on-going personal, social, or professional service which directly benefits the persons served, residents or administrative functions of the Community Service Board of Middle Georgia without monetary compensation. Volunteer or trainee participation shall be open to persons of both sexes, and of all ages, races, creeds, and national origin. Volunteers or trainees participating shall comply with State and Federal Laws, and Official Administrative Policies of the Community Service Board of Middle Georgia, Department of Community Health, Health Care Facility Regulation Division, CARF, and the Department of Behavioral Health and Developmental Disabilities.
