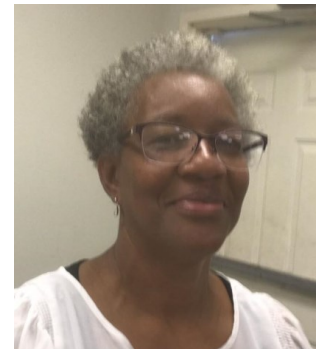


# Hearts of Our Heroes

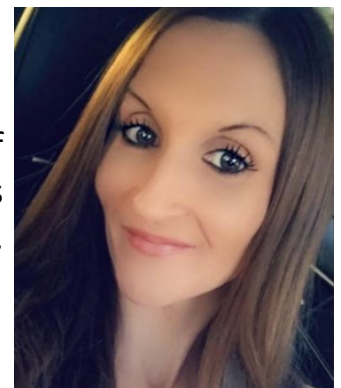
