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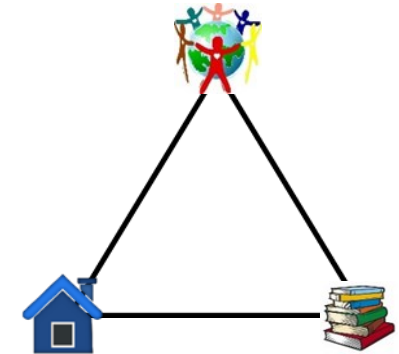

Community Service Board of Middle GA is proud to offer the Georgia Apex Program. The Program is a new grant funded school based behavioral health program & partnership.

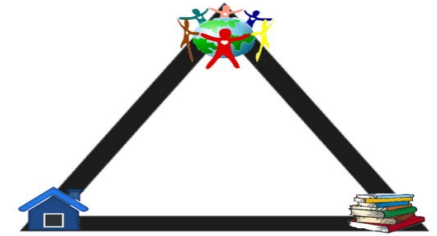
Students, families & schools will have access to highly skilled & trained on-site staff.
