Apex and SOC programs are designed to provide a comprehensive and unique set of services for students in a school setting. Services are provided in the schools so that the student's education is not interrupted.

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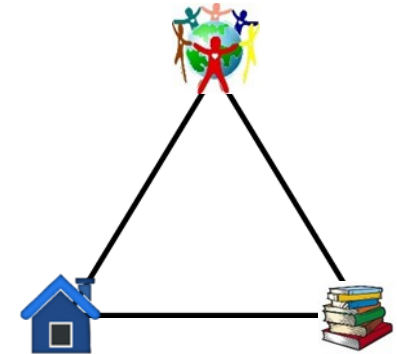
