Getting Started

1. Secure a copy of your child's evaluation which includes test results, a diagnosis of autism and a prescription for ABA therapy. The evaluation must be conducted by a licensed physician or psychologist and is required to start the intake process.
2. Visit CSBMG for an intake appointment to establish services with our facility and receive our ABA specific intake packet
3. Once we receive your intake information, we will call you to schedule an initial appointment with our therapy staff for a comprehensive assessment to determine what areas your child needs help in and to set up their specific treatment plan
