When you contact us, you'll be provided with information on how to access services through the Region 2 & Region 5 Field Office Intake and Evaluation Team.

Privacy:

CSB of Middle Georgia follows all HIPAA guidelines as defined by federal law. All information you give to us is confidential and can not be given out without written consent except in the case of a medical emergency, when there is a danger to yourself or someone else, or when court ordered to do so. We release information to insurance companies, Medicaid and Medicare, based on your consent during intake.

Fees:

Every individual who enters our program must receive funding through Medicaid Waiver services, State Contracted Services, or will be responsible to self-pay for all services provided by CSB of Middle Georgia.

Day Program:

There are Eight (8) day programs in our sixteen county service area. Each program is person centered and teaches skill development that will increase the work opportunities for developmentally disabled citizens as well as promote involvement in community activities.

The programs provide:

- Community Access Services
- Prevocational Services
- Supported Employment
- Other Educational/Recreational Activities

Community Living Supports:

The Community Living Supports (CLS) program provides support for adults who live on their own or with family members. CLS is provided throughout our service areas.

Support is given in:

- Budgeting
- Household Management
- Transportation
- Community Based Services

Group Homes:

There are eight (8) Community Residential Arrangements (CRA) that provide room and board. The homes are located in Dodge, Laurens and Treutlen counties.

The homes offer:

- Recreational/Leisure outings
- Transportation
- Self-Supervision of Medication
- Meals
- Assistance with Reaching Your Goals

Rehab Option Services:

Psychosocial Rehabilitation Individual (PRI) offers treatment to individuals with dual diagnosis of behavioral health in addition to developmental disabilities.

- Crisis Intervention
- Evaluation Services
- Medication Management
- Education

Supported Employment Services:

Assisting individuals with job placement within the community.

Services include:

- Job Readiness Training
- Job Coaching
- Job Placement
