Case Management

This is a case management program that engages with incarcerated individuals who suffer from mental illness, behavioral health, substance abuse, and/or have a history of homelessness to create and establish a community transition plan. Linkage to community-based services for Individuals transition back to their community is a vital part of reentry. Case Management services come at no cost to the participating jails, nor the clients being assisted. The goal is to assist the clients in getting the needed treatment, and recourses upon release of the county jail in hopes of stopping the client from relapsing.

Community Service Board of Middle Georgia is offering these services to incarcerated individuals in all of our 16 counties.

CSBMG is working on providing peer support for all incarcerated individuals struggling with substance use disorders and/or mental/behavioral health issues. This program offers All Recovery meetings and individual support to any person incarcerated in our 16 counties and comes at no cost to participating jails and/or individuals receiving this support. In addition to from All Recovery meetings and individual support the peers can also be utilized to help link people to services, screen for substance use issues, make appointments for intakes and link to other community resources. Peers will also be working closely with our Case Manager and corresponding CSBMG locations to provide warm hand offs when applicable.
