CASE MANAGEMENT



Case Management services consist of providing environmental support and care coordination considered essential to assist individuals with improving his/her functioning, gaining access to necessary services, and creating an environment that promotes recovery as identified in his/her Individual Recovery Plan (IRP).



The focus of interventions includes assisting the individual with:

- 1) developing natural supports to promote community integration;
- 2) identifying service needs;
- 3) referring and linking to services and resources identified through the service planning process;
- 4) coordinating services identified on the IRP to maximize service integration and minimize service gaps; and
- 5) ensuring continued adequacy of the IRP to meet ongoing and changing needs.
