Family Support Services is a dynamic cooperative program funded by the Georgia Department of Behavioral Health and Developmental Disabilities to help relieve the financial strain on people or families with a developmental disability.



Eligibility:

Individuals aged four (4) and up with a diagnosed developmental disability living in Georgia at home with their families and are not currently receiving a NOW/COMP Waiver, are eligible for Family Support Services

Eligible Diagnoses include:

- Developmental Disability
- Intellectual Disability
- Cerebral Palsy
- Autism Spectrum Disorders
- Down Syndrome
